1. Thave probable cause to believe that on 01/23/2020, at 903 JEFFERSON ST, COLUMBIA, MO 65203, WILLEM DAKOTAH CAMPBELL W. committed one or more criminal offense(s): 565.054-002Y201713 ASSAULT - 3RD DEGREE F/M: F COUNTS: 1 CHARGE TYPE: S

569.120-001M201629 PROPERTY DAMAGE 2ND DEGREE F/M: M COUNTS: 1 CHARGE TYPE: S

579.074-002Y201735 UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA - ERICE DRUG OFFEN F/M: M COUNTS: 1 CHARGE TYPE: S

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows: On 01/23/2020, I was dispatched to 903 Jefferson Street, in Columbia, Boone County, Missouri, for a reported assault with a weapon. When I arrived I made contact with the victim RK, who stated a male attacked him in his driveway of 903 Jefferson Street, with a blunt object he described as " a long metal pipe". The suspect fled prior to officers arriving.

I spoke with RK who stated he was driving home on the night of 01/23/2020 and saw a male wearing all black, standing in the middle of Benton Street. The male was later identified as Willem Campbell, RK stated he could tell Campbell was holding something behind his back. RK stated Campbell started yelling at him so he drove past the male. RK stated he was parking his vehicle in his driveway and he saw Campbell running towards his vehicle. RK stated Campbell was yelling at him, but RK could not understand what Campbell was saying. RK stated Campbell had what he described as " a long metal pipe" and struck RK's windshield with the metal pipe. When Campbell struck RK's windshield with the metal pipe, a small crack formed in the right side of the windshield. RK stated the window would need to be replaced and would cost approximately \$300 to fix. RK then stated Campbell came to the driver side door, opened it and began to strike RK with the metal pipe. RK had no visible injuries at the time I was talking to him, but RK was limping and could hardly walk. RK stated he was struck in the right knee and RK stated he had a prosthetic knee. RK was wincing in pain while I was speaking with him.

Officers were able to locate Campbell at 1205 North Garth Avenue. I drove RK to 1205 North Garth for a show up. RK positively identified Campbell as the male who attacked him. I then placed Campbell under arrest. Upon searching Campbell Officers located multiple used needles, which I know from my training and experience used needles are typically used for drugs.
