



Victim, M.F. stated he was in the entrance area of the south west exit of the store when Jackson approached him. M.F. stated Jackson told him to "Get Back," multiple times. M.F. stated he was in the east portion of the entrance area when Jackson fired 7 times into the store.

Victim, B.W stated he was on the west portion of the entrance of the entrance when he observed Jackson fire 6 to 7 shots. B.W. stated he observed Jackson flee the scene directly after the shots.

A witness D.R. stated she observed Jackson fire his firearm into the store. D.R. positively identified Jackson while he was detained by officers at a nearby location.

Victim, J.M. stated he was in the self checkout station closest to the entrance where the incident was occurring with his daughter, O.M. ( who is under the age of 17) when he observed Jackson fire his weapon towards the staff and his direction.

Another victim, K.S stated he was by the entrance where the incident took place when he observed Jackson coming towards him with a weapon. K.S. stated he heard Jackson state "He shouldn't have tackled me." K.S. advised Jackson stated "I'm a [REDACTED] cap him, I'm a [REDACTED] cap you guys." in reference to Walmart Staff. K.S. stated he observed Jackson exhibit his firearm multiple times while he was pacing in the front of the entrance. K.S. stated Jackson stated "I'm a cap you guys, you don't know who I am." K.S. stated he was at the west side of the entrance when Jackson opened fire.


All victims stated the shots came through two sets of store windows, multiple witnesses stated Jackson fired the weapon approximately 6 times towards the staff located near the front door shooting into the building. I located 6 shell casings where multiple victims stated Jackson fired his weapon from. While at the Columbia Police Department after a Post Miranda interview Jackson admitted to firing the weapon into the Walmart. Jackson also admitted to placing the firearm in the floorboard of the front passenger side of the suspect vehicle. The weapon was located in the immediate vicinity of where Jackson was sitting in the vehicle used to flee. It was later learned the weapon was defaced and confirmed stolen.

It should be noted Jackson was previously arrested for Robbery in the 1st degree while in possession of a stolen firearm.
