- 1. I have probable cause to believe that on 04/06/2019, at 51 BROADWAY VILLAGE DR - G, COLUMBIA, MO 65201, HENOK G WOLDU B/M [REDACTED] committed one or more criminal offense(s): 566.100-003Y201311 SEXUAL ABUSE - 1ST DEGREE F/M: F COUNTS: 1 CHARGE TYPE:

- 2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows: On 04/05/2019 victim [REDACTED] went out for drinks [REDACTED] Henok Woldu. The victim reported during the evening [REDACTED] was encouraged repeatedly to drink alcoholic beverages by Woldu. The victim said Woldu bought some of the beverages for [REDACTED]

The victim said Woldu convinced [REDACTED] to go into a dance club located within the Tiger Hotel in downtown Columbia. The victim said [REDACTED] was provided more alcoholic beverages by Woldu, until [REDACTED] reached a point of incapacitation which caused [REDACTED] to think [REDACTED] may have been drugged.

The victim said [REDACTED] went into the bathroom where [REDACTED] got onto the floor and was unable to get [REDACTED] up. The victim said someone came into the bathroom and allowed Woldu to remove [REDACTED]. The victim reported feeling as though [REDACTED] was unable to move on [REDACTED] own but was able to clearly remember what happened.

The victim said Woldu drove [REDACTED] to his home at 51 Broadway Village Dr (APT G), despite knowing where [REDACTED] lives. The victim said once in Woldu's home, he removed all of [REDACTED] clothing, and placed [REDACTED] in his bed. The victim reported feeling like an "animal" the way Woldu was treating [REDACTED]

The victim said Woldu disrobed and got into the bed. The victim said once Woldu had placed [REDACTED] into his bed, he touched [REDACTED] naked body with his hands. The victim reported telling Woldu to stop and being physically unable to push him away. The victim reported feeling Woldu rub his penis on [REDACTED] while saying "oh god".

The victim said [REDACTED] passed out and had no further memory until waking in Woldu's bed the next morning. The victim reported not feeling any pain in [REDACTED] but experiencing a [REDACTED]. The victim did not think Woldu penetrated [REDACTED] with his penis, but was unsure.

The victim later secretly recorded a private conversation with Woldu where he admitted his knowledge of [REDACTED] incapacitation. Woldu admitted to the sexual

abuse, and told the victim it was human nature. Woldu further inferred the victim should be grateful he stopped without raping [REDACTED]

A security guard D.A. who was working in the Tiger Hotel dance club, later provided a body camera video of the victim being removed from the bathroom. The victim had clearly been vomiting into the toilet and was on the ground when he entered. The victim had to be helped to stand by Woldu and appeared to be unable to stand or walk on [REDACTED] own. 
