I did a reopening inspection to verify they could reopen their kitchen about a week and a half ago. During this inspection we went over with a manager all changes that would need to be made (no bar seating, social distancing guidelines, occ load, etc.). A couple days later a coworker showed me a video from social media that showed they still had seating at the bar, and it appeared to have quite a few people in the establishment. I did a follow up inspection the next day to address the complaint and issues from the previous inspection, and they had multiple patrons at the bar, seated, and no social distancing at their tables. This was all documented, and they moved the bar seating on site. The most recent complaint was that the establishment was packed Friday/Saturday night from this past weekend, with bar seating, etc. Based on this track record, I feel that it is very likely that Room 38 is operating business as usual and ignoring all guidelines we have discussed at length with management.
