DISTRICT COVID-19 STATUS CHANGE ANNOUNCMENT

10/21/2020

Dear Parents:

Effective upon dismissal from school today, the South Callaway R-II School District will move to our previously published Plan D: The Distance Learning Plan of School Attendance. This change is being made due to an increase in the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases among staff members, and the quarantine status of their colleagues.

Plan D will be in effect through Friday, 10/30/20, and we expect to return to Plan A: In-Person Student Attendance on Monday, 11/2/20.

Plan D COVID-19 Status means that:

- Students will attend school online beginning with the half-day schedule on Thursday.
- South Callaway teachers will deploy instruction through Class Dojo, Schoology, or a previously-arranged alternative method of instruction. Students should login to their classes for specific teacher instructions.
- Friday, 10/23 is a previously scheduled day off per the District Calendar and will be observed. Classes begin again on Monday, 10/26 with students logging in through Class Dojo and Schoology.
- The campus is closed to the public with the exception of authorized personnel.
- No activities will be held on campus and our students will not participate in activities off campus through 10/30.

The Virtual Parent-Teacher Conferences scheduled for Thursday, 10/22/20 will be held as planned.

This five and a half day move to Plan D will provide time for us to fully implement our CDC and Callaway County Health Department-approved safety protocols while ensuring a continuity of education for our students at the same time. We thank you for your continued cooperation and assistance in our mission to protect the health and safety of our staff and students. We have said it before, but it's a message worth repeating: COVID-19 Can't Stop Our Bulldogs' Quest for Academic Success!
