DISTRICT COVID-19 STATUS CHANGE ANNOUNCMENT

11/9/20

Dear Parents:

Effective upon dismissal from school today, <u>South Callaway R-II High School ONLY will move to our previously published Plan D: The Distance Learning Plan of School Attendance.</u> This change is being made due to an increase in the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and associated quarantines. One of these two situations affect over one-quarter of the HS student body and approximately one-third of the HS staff.

At this time, <u>ALL other buildings in the District remain in the Plan A: In-</u>
<u>Person Student Attendance</u>. Although positive cases and some quarantines do exist in the Early Childhood, the Elementary School, and the Middle School, these buildings have not been impacted as much as the High School.

Plan D will be in effect for the High School through Friday, November 13 and we expect to return to Plan A: In-Person Student Attendance beginning Monday, November 16 for those who are not under quarantine on that date.

Plan D COVID-19 Status means that:

- South Callaway High School teachers will deploy instruction through Schoology, or a previously-arranged alternative method of instruction. Students should login to their classes for specific teacher instructions.
- High School students participating in after-school activities should contact their coach or sponsor for directions.
- Students and staff who are not under quarantine on November 16, should plan to return to in-person attendance. Students and staff who remain under quarantine should plan to return per their individual instruction from the Callaway County Department of Health.

This temporary move to Plan D will provide time for us to fully implement our CDC and Callaway County Health Department-approved safety protocols while ensuring a continuity of education for our students at the same time. We thank you for your continued cooperation and assistance in our mission to protect the health and safety of our staff and students.
