**JUDGMENT AND ORDER**

NOW ON THIS 30<sup>th</sup> day of January 2023 this cause comes on for hearing. Plaintiff appears in person and by counsel Brent Haden. Defendants appear by counsel Natalie Hoernschemeyer and Grant Wiens. Intervenor Boone County Clerk appears in person and by Boone County Counselor CJ Dykhouse. Cause heard and submitted. The Court, being fully advised in the premises, enters the following Judgment and Order:

The Court grants Defendants David Seamon, Chris Horn, Katherine Sasser, Jeanne Snodgrass, Helen Wade, Suzette Waters, and Blake Willoughby’s motion to dismiss all claims against them in Plaintiff’s First Amended Petition.

The Court finds that the Declaration of Candidacy filed by Plaintiff with Intervenor is a legal nullity. The Court further finds in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendants Columbia Public Schools and Columbia Public Schools Board of Education on Count I of Plaintiff’s First Amended Petition. Intervenor Boone County Clerk is directed to add “Charles (Chuck) Basye” to the list of submitted candidates to serve as director of the Board of Education of Columbia Public Schools for the April 4, 2023, Municipal and School Election.


Court costs taxed in the amount of \$133.57 against Defendant Columbia Public Schools.
