Upon receiving the call, communications relayed the individual stated, he had a shotgun and wanted his body to be found. Shortly after communications relayed hearing the audible sound of a shotgun slide being racked, a gunshot, and then the phone call ended.

Myself and additional units responded emergency to Schurz Hall where we began to search the bathrooms for the possible victim. Units began to search the bathrooms of Schurz, Hatch, and Bingham Hall starting on the first floor and basement. After the initial sweep of the first floor, a command post was established and two-man contact teams were then sent floor to floor to clear the bathrooms. There was nothing found in either of the three Halls.

Once all the bathrooms were cleared in Schurz, Hatch, and Bingham Hall teams were then directed to search bathrooms in the surrounding Resident Halls. Residential Life Staff members were requested to meet officers in the lobby of the following Halls: College, Respect, Responsibility, Discovery, Excellence, and Hudson. The buildings were cleared going floor to floor by two-man contact teams. There was nothing found in any of the before-mentioned Halls.

While Halls were being searched there were many students roaming around the halls and common areas. All of the students denied hearing or seeing anything out of the ordinary.

Units were then instructed to return to the Police department where a debrief and discussion were performed.

MUPD Dispatch contacted multiple cellular carriers in an attempt to identify a owner and ping the phone location but, none were able to identify the number. Eventually, the number associated with the call is (604) 644-4377 was connected to Rogers Communications Canada Inc. out of The Greater Vancouver County, British Columbia. Communications could not locate customer service contact information and were unable to contact local law enforcement.

The incident was recorded on my body-worn camera and uploaded to Evidence.com
