FELONY COMPLAINT

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Monroe, State of Missouri, charges that the Defendant, acting alone or in concert with others:

COUNT I

in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the class A felony of **MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE** punishable upon conviction under Section 565.020, RSMo, in that on or about on or about December 17, 2021, in the County of Monroe, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused the death of [REDACTED] by striking her.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement of facts concerning this matter, which statements are made a part hereof and are submitted herewith as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause for the issuance of the warrant.

WHEREFORE, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
