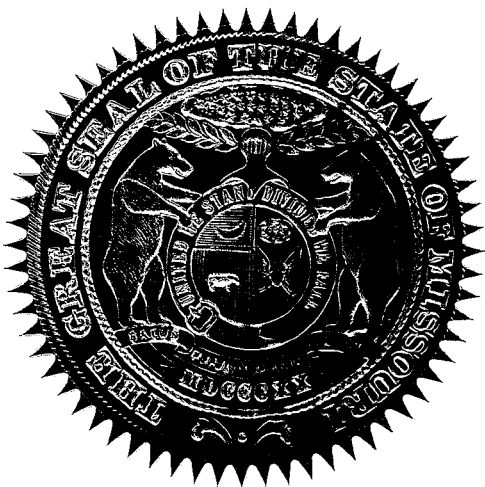


TO ALL WHO SHALL SEE THESE PRESENTS, GREETING:

I, MICHAEL L. PARSON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, have considered a Commutation of Britt Reid’s sentence of three (3) years’ imprisonment in the Missouri Department of Corrections imposed on the 1st day of November, 2022, by judgment of the Circuit Court of Jackson County in case number 2116-CR01457-01. This sentence resulted from Britt Reid’s conviction for the offense of Driving While Intoxicated under Section 577.010, Revised Statutes of Missouri and punishable under the same.

After examination of the facts relevant thereto, I hereby grant Britt Reid a limited commutation of the above sentence and do therefore convert the remainder of Britt Reid’s sentence, from the date of this order to October 31, 2025, to house arrest pursuant to Section 217.541, Revised Statutes of Missouri. This house arrest shall be subject to the following additional terms and conditions: (a) employment of at least 30 hours per week, (b) installation of an ignition interlock system in any motor vehicle Reid operates, (c) random screening for intoxicating substances, (d) weekly meetings with a probation and parole officer, (e) weekly attendance of behavioral counseling or support programming, (f) weekly meetings with a peer support sponsor, (g) completion of at least 10 hours per month of community service, (h) no contact with the victim of the above offense or the victim’s family unless otherwise legally required, and (i) compliance with all conditions in 14 CSR 80-3.010 and any terms and conditions imposed by the Parole Board that do not directly conflict with this commutation; and Britt Reid shall be subject to the supervision thereof. Nothing in this commutation shall limit the Parole Board’s lawful discretion or authority to revoke Britt Reid’s house arrest and return him to the Missouri Department of Corrections if Reid violates any of these terms and conditions. This limited commutation shall not otherwise shorten the duration of the three (3) year sentence imposed nor limit the Parole Board’s authority.
