The court informed the defendant of verdict/finding, asks the defendant whether (s)he has anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced, and finds that no sufficient cause to the contrary has been shown or appears to the court.

Defendant has been advised of his/her rights to file a motion for post-conviction relief pursuant to **Supreme Court Rule 24.035/29.15** and the court has found **No Probable Cause** to believe that defendant has received ineffective assistance of counsel.

The Court orders:

Pursuant to section **558.0312, RSMo**, Defendant shall receive credit of _____ days toward the service of Defendant's sentence for time spent in prison, jail, or custody after the offense occurred and before conviction.

The clerk to deliver a certified copy of the judgment and commitment to the sheriff.

The sheriff to authorize one additional officer/guard to transport defendant to Department of Corrections.

That Judgment entered in favor of the State of Missouri and against the defendant for the sum of **\$68.00** for the Crime Victims Compensation fund. Judgment is **Not Satisfied**.

The Court further orders:

Defendant appears on Department of Corrections video with atty C. Miller, State by Gonzo, State given leave to file Sub Information, FORMAL ARRAIGNMENT WAIVED, State nolle Counts 2,4,5 and 6.

Plea(s) of guilty entered to count(s) one and three.

Court finds plea(s) of guilty made freely and voluntarily with understanding of nature of charge, range of punishment and consequences thereof. Court further finds that Defendant knowingly and intelligently waived certain rights and that Defendant has had effective assistance of counsel. Court finds BYRD that Defendant is a persistent offender.

Punishment fixed as follows:

Count 1: 20 years MODOC

Count 3: 15 years MODOC, CC and CC with any other Department of Corrections sentences.

Allocution, Judgment and Sentence.

Defendant given credit for time served.

Civil judgment in accordance with law.

Defendant advised of rights under Supreme Court Rule 24.035 and inquiry conducted as to assistance of counsel. Court finds no probable cause to believe that defendant has not been effectively represented by counsel. KC/III (vmb)
